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# Background

- **Nairobi Metropolitan Services Improvement Project (NaMSIP)** is one of the four donor- funded projects under the State Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- **Nairobi Metropolitan Region** includes five counties namely: Nairobi, Kiambu, Kajiado, Machakos and Muranga.
- **Project Objective:** To strengthen urban services and infrastructure in the Nairobi Metropolitan Region.
- **NaMSIP** is a World Bank supported project that became effective on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2012 with a five year project design but a two year extension was granted to the project pushing the end date to May 2019.
- The total project cost is USD330 million (USD 300 million and GoK USD30 million).

# The project components

The project has four components namely;

- **Institutional Reform and Planning** - US\$15million. Supports the Nairobi metropolitan counties in capacity enhancement and planning activities
- **County Government Infrastructure and Services-** US\$ 60 million. Finances priority urban infrastructure in 13 metro urban centres
- **Metropolitan Infrastructure & Services-** US\$ 250 million. Providing large scale metropolitan infrastructure in solid waste, transport and sewerage services.
- **Project Management, Monitoring & Evaluation-** US\$ 5 million. Finances the management activities associated with project implementation including establishing and implementing a comprehensive M&E system and training of implementing agencies in environmental and social management.

# Major Achievements

**Project Status:** The project has made the following progress towards meeting its objective.

Major Achievements include:

- Construction of Ruiru Sewerage
- The Security/Street Lighting in 13 urban metro centres
- Ngong Bus Park
- Strategic access roads to Railway Stations (Ruiru, Kikuyu and Limuru); Imara Daima, Manyani Estate, Juja Circuit roads and access road to Juja Railway Station
- Construction of 69 km Konza – Machakos – Tala - Kagundo– Kenol.

# Projects in Kajiado County

- Proposed construction of Parking Bays, Bicycles and Pedestrian Pathways in Ngong and Kitengela Townships; award letters issued
- Construction of modern Bus Park in Kitengela Town; commencement order issued.
- Consultancy for revenue Enhancement studies for Machakos, Kiambu, Murang'a and **Kajiado**.
- Storm Water Drainage for Ongata Rongai township.

# Kajiado projects/consultancies con't

- Ongoing proposals for construction of *Ongata Rongai (Ole Kasasi)* and Ngong markets; Consultancy services for feasibility studies, designs and have been approved.
- Provision of non-motorized transport; Feasibility studies, designs and tender for Ngong and Ongata Rongai *in progress*
- Supply Installation and commissioning of Street and Security Lighting in Kitengela, Ngong and Ongata Rongai; complete

# Challenges and proposed solutions

- Accessibility to proposed Kajiado Sanitary Landfill Site to conduct investigations and designs
- Land acquisition -Land ownership documents are yet to be obtained for some of the proposed markets , bus parks and parking bays.
- The ministry has stepped in and is assisting the Counties obtain these necessary documents without which investments will not be possible.

# Sustainability

- Sustainability of investments in infrastructure and service delivery depend on incentives and availability of resources for operations and maintenance.
- NaMSIP finances infrastructure investments only if the county government or relevant service provider takes responsibility for operating and maintaining the assets such as street lighting or drainage. .
